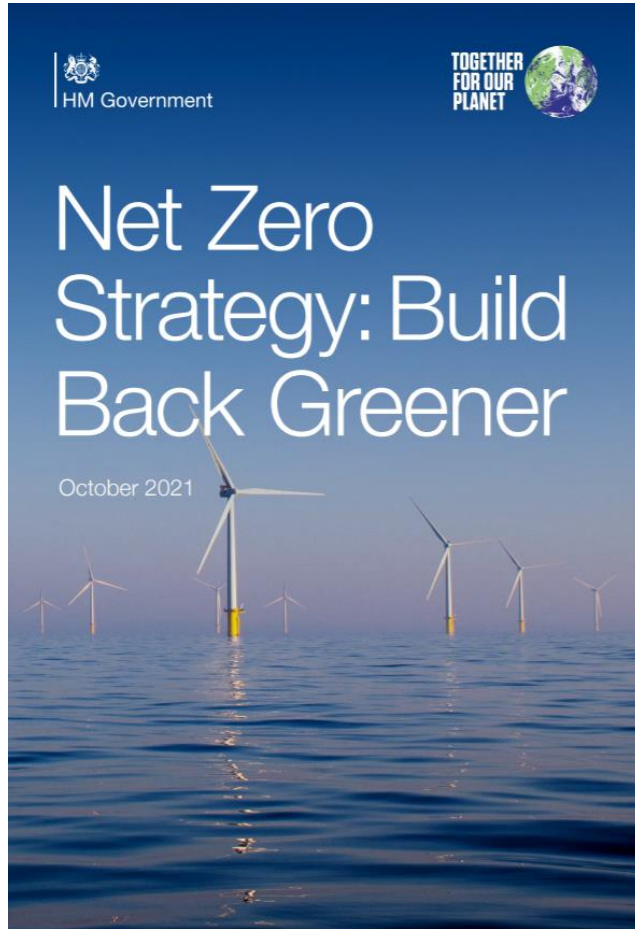

Introducing the **Future Homes Standard** in 2025 to ensure **all new homes in England** are Net Zero ready with a **high standard of energy efficiency and low carbon heating as standard.**

---

Introducing an **uplift in standards** from 2022, for England resulting in a **31% reduction in carbon emissions from new homes compared to current standards.**

---

**Consult on whether its appropriate to end new gas grid connections.**

---

Supporting **175,000 green skilled jobs by 2030 and 240,000 by 2035**

---

**Aiming to phase out the installation of new and replacement natural gas boilers by 2035**

---

**Growing the heat pump market to support 600,000 installations per year by 2028**

---

£450m Boiler Upgrade Scheme

---

**Consulting on phasing out coal, LPG and oil heating**

---

Upgrading fuel poor homes to EPC Band C by 2030 were reasonably practical

---

Consulting on higher minimum performance standards across all tenures so homes meet EPC Band C by 2035, where cost-effective, practical and affordable.

---

Providing £800 million additional funding to the Social Housing Decarbonisation Fund (SHDF) over 2022/23 to 2024/25

---

Provide £950 million additional funding over 2022/23 to 2024/25 for off-gas-grid properties through the Home Upgrade Grant (HUG)

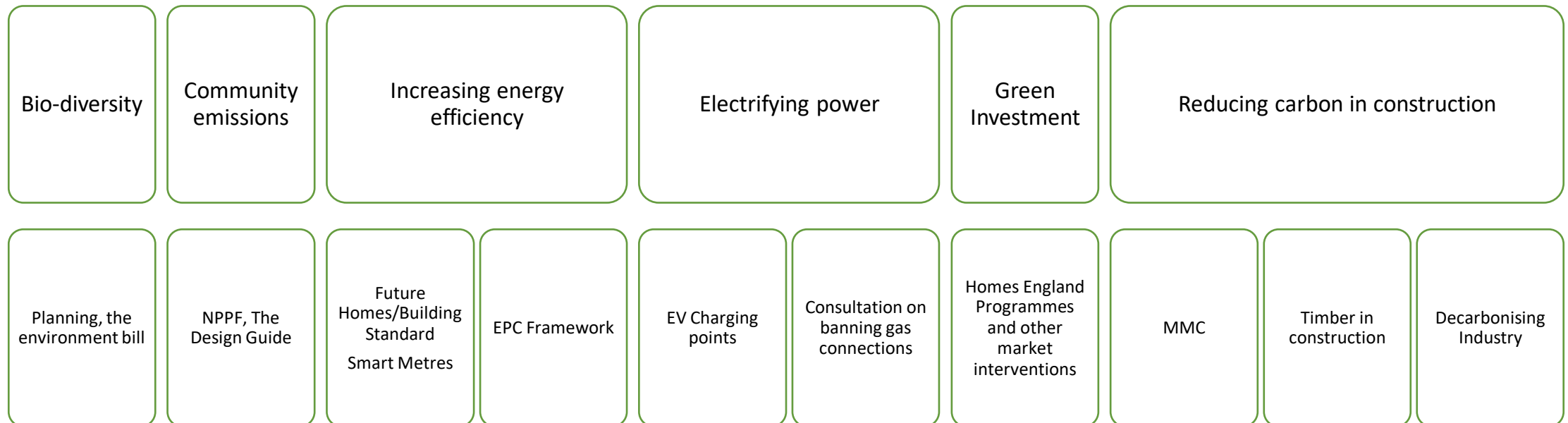

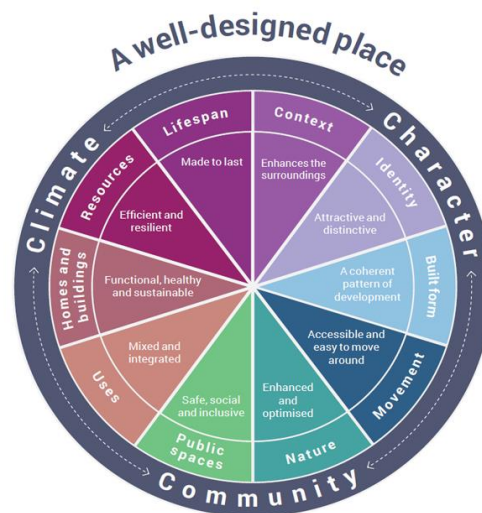

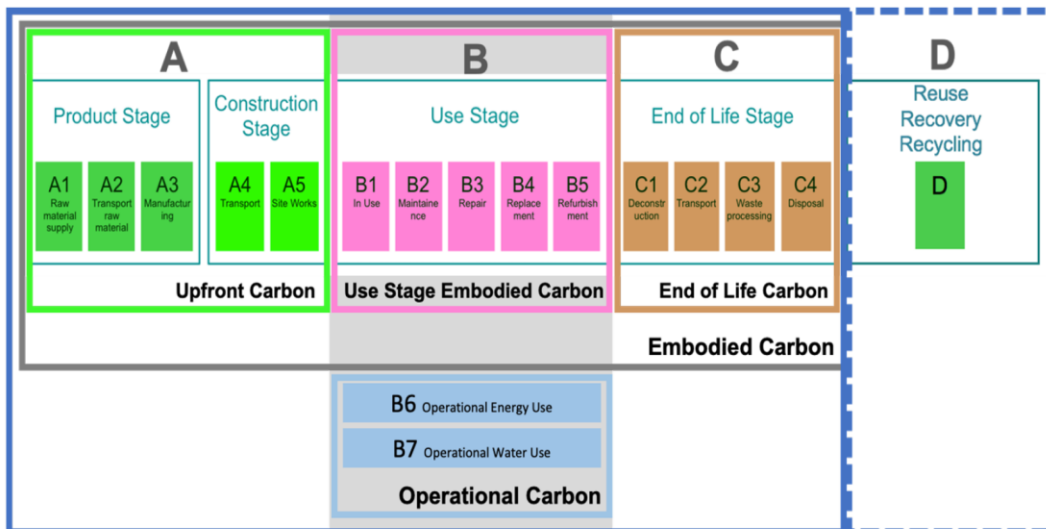
