## Comparison of the RSR data tables published by the Housing Corporation in 2005 and 2006

Each year the Housing Corporation publishes a set of tables summarising the information provided by Registered Social Landlords (RSLs) in the Regulatory and Statistical Return (RSR).

The aim of this report is to provide a guide on the content and comparability of the RSR 2006 tables with those produced in 2005. The RSR 2005 tables are used as a reference point for the comparison.

These notes focus specifically on the changes applied to the return in 2006, and it should be used in conjunction with its sister paper, *The RSR Dataset in 2006: Technical Notes*, available free from the Dataspring website (<a href="www.dataspring.org.uk">www.dataspring.org.uk</a>) and from the Housing Corporation's RSR website (<a href="www.rsrsurvey.co.uk">www.rsrsurvey.co.uk</a>).

In 2006, there were no major changes to the definitions or questions asked in the RSR. However, information requested from RSLs who completed a Short return was significantly cut in 2006 and this has been noted where appropriate in the tables. For example, the Short return no longer required RSLs to report on non-social housing, or other non-housing activities and the information requested by bed size and local authority area was also shortened.

This paper includes details of what data are shown in each of the RSR tables and brief notes where required to explain any differences.
